Auction Rules:

- a. Any person wishing to auction must be a current member, however any person will be permitted to buy.
- b. The club receives 10% of the sale price to the nearest 5 cents, up to a maximum of \$10
- c. If a coin is sold to the original owner, owner will pay the club commission. (Use your reserve bid to protect your coin) Reserves to be announced before bidding begins.
- d. Ten coins or lots will be allowed per member. More on auctioneer's request.
- e. Bidding will be 5 cents on copper and tokens, 10 cents on silver and paper and 25 cents above two dollars on the auctioneer's decision.
- f. Purchasers not satisfied with their purchases must return the purchase immediately to the runner. No questions asked.
- g. All purchases will be paid for at time of sale to the runner.
- h. All purchases of coins paid for by cheque must be sanctioned by and accepted by the seller of the coin. The seller of the coin will pay the club commission in cash.
- i. The club auctioneer will be in charge of all auctions. The auctioneer shall be appointed at the May meeting.
